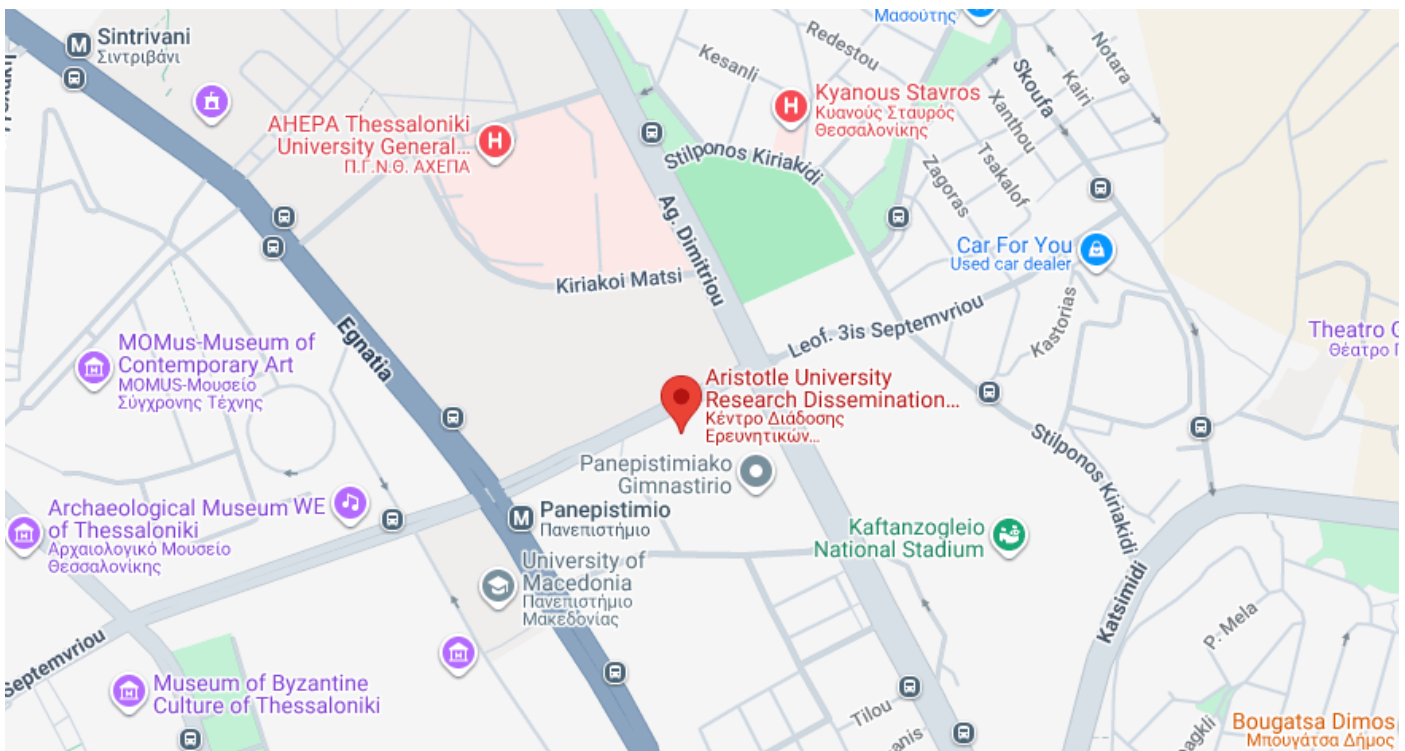
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Location of the Venue:

On Google Maps you can search for “Aristotle University Research Dissemination Center (KEDEA)”, and it would show on the map as depicted in the following picture:



Traveling to the Venue:

The Aristotle University Research Dissemination Center (KEDEA) is located on 3rd September Street, approximately 1.5 km from the city center. Its **red color** makes it easily distinguishable (see image on the right). The venue can be reached easily by public transportation, taxi, car, bicycle, or on foot. Public transport includes:

- **Metro:** Take the metro to Panepistimio station; the venue is within walking distance.
- **Bus:** Several lines serve stops close to the venue, including 2, 7, 14, 17, 24, 27, 28, 37, 58 and 83. The closest stops include University of Macedonia, Foititiki Leschi, and Panepistimia



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Travel & Accommodation Information

Travelling to Thessaloniki

Thessaloniki is easily accessible by **air, rail, road, and bus**. The city is served by **Thessaloniki International Airport “Makedonia” (SKG)**, with direct flights from several European cities and connecting flights through major European hubs.

- **By air:** Thessaloniki International Airport is approximately 15 km from the city center. Taxis and public transportation connect the airport with central Thessaloniki.
- **By train:** Regular rail services connect Thessaloniki with **Athens and other major Greek cities**.
- **By road:** Thessaloniki is connected to the national motorway network, making it accessible by car and coach from Athens and other Greek cities.

Staying in Thessaloniki

Thessaloniki offers multiple options in the city centre with convenient access to the meeting venue. Some options are:

- **ABC Hotel:** Particularly convenient for the conference: directly across from the university campus and just steps from Sintrivani Metro Station
- **City Hotel Thessaloniki:** Central option close to Aristotelous Square, restaurants, and the waterfront
- **Egnatia Palace Hotel & Spa:** Centrally located near Aristotelous Square and within easy reach of the university
- **Superior One Boutique Hotel:** Boutique option on Ionos Dragoumi, centrally located and convenient for the city center
- **No 15 Ermou Hotel:** Modern hotel on Ermou Street, with easy access to the city center and public transport
- **Domotel Olympia:** Elegant boutique hotel on Olympou Street featuring minimalist design, just a 5-minute walk from Aristotelous Square and Venizelou Metro Station

Moving around in Thessaloniki

Thessaloniki is a **compact and walkable city**, with most major sights easily accessible on foot or by public transport. If you have time, feel free to explore the waterfront and the iconic White Tower, stroll through Aristotelous Square, discover the historic Ano Poli and Byzantine Walls, and visit landmarks such as the Roman Forum and Rotunda. For food and nightlife, the lively Ladadika district is a must. The city’s brand-new **metro** is an attraction by itself (make sure to check the Venizelou station) and makes getting around easy, while many central attractions are just a short walk from one another.
